RE: Tenurgy Recommendation

To Whom It May Concern,

Farmington Public Schools was recently contacted to partner with Tenurgy for a review of the school district's electric and natural gas invoices. This service was provided at no cost to the District, noting that any potential savings would be split 50/50 with Farmington Public Schools. Colin Green, a senior analyst with Tenurgy, was extremely polite in explaining Tenurgy's program and its history in helping districts across the state.

Tenurgy's review was completed within a few weeks with minimal time or assistance required. The final report (including a follow up online conference) identified a savings opportunity going forward by consolidating gas accounts. An analysis of the District's electric supply (DTE) determined that the District was receiving an exceptional rate under the MISEC program and that no additional savings could be realized under the current rate plan.

Although the savings from consolidating a couple of service accounts with Consumers appear minimal, the District will be using Tenurgy in the future for an analysis of its water and sewer billing. My experience with Tenurgy has been both positive and informative.
